What is the standard voltage for a power socket in El Salvador?

All power sockets in El Salvador provide a standard voltage of 115V with a standard frequency of 60Hz. You can use all your equipment in El Salvador if the outlet voltage in your own country is between 100V-127V. This is mostly the case in the US, Canada and countries in South America. The standard frequency in El Salvador is 60Hz.

Which plugs fit in a type B socket in El Salvador?

Plugs of type A will also fit into a type B socket. If you're not sure whether the outlets and plugs used in your country are the same as in El Salvador, you can use the tool at the top of this page to check if you need a travel adapter. All power sockets in El Salvador provide a standard voltage of 115V with a standard frequency of 60Hz.
